Must have a desire to continually improve professionally and have a willingness to apply ones knowledge and skills to the betterment of the operating unit.• Work in any electrical related activity – for example conduit bracket fabrication, installing conduit, pulling wire, general troubleshooting.• Communicate issues on a daily basis to the maintenance superintendent, operations supervisor and other maintenance personnel.• Write, update, and complete work orders as needed.• Able to learn new technology as it is introduced on the plant site and be able to transfer the knowledge to others, including supervision, production and maintenance personnel.• Must be familiar with instrument calibration.• Must be familiar with computer hardware and software.• Follow and promote plant site electrical and process control standards.• Wear/use a variety of personal protective and safety equipment per company standards.• Familiar with reading 3-view working drawings and schematics.
