<b>Position Description</b>	This position maintains repairs, modifies and installs electrical/instrument/computer systems in a wood products manufacturing facility to ensure optimal operations and product flow.
<b>Position Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ability to work in a safe manner and comply with all policies and regulations.</li><li>• Possess good troubleshooting skills with the ability to repair electrical problems occurring during manufacturing processes.</li><li>• Work effectively and safely in a production environment, being flexible and completing deadlines on a short notice.</li><li>• Must be a positive, proactive self-starter who works equally well alone as well as with others. Must have a desire to continually improve professionally and have a willingness to apply ones knowledge and skills to the betterment of the operating unit.</li><li>• Work in any electrical related activity – for example conduit bracket fabrication, installing conduit, pulling wire, general troubleshooting.</li><li>• Communicate issues on a daily basis to the maintenance superintendent, operations supervisor and other maintenance personnel.</li><li>• Write, update, and complete work orders as needed.</li><li>• Able to learn new technology as it is introduced on the plant site and be able to transfer the knowledge to others, including supervision, production and maintenance personnel.</li><li>• Must be familiar with instrument calibration.</li><li>• Must be familiar with computer hardware and software.</li><li>• Follow and promote plant site electrical and process control standards.</li><li>• Wear/use a variety of personal protective and safety equipment per company standards.</li><li>• Familiar with reading 3-view working drawings and schematics.</li></ul>
<b>Position Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Possess a current Oregon State Plant Manufacturing Electrical license.</li><li>• Communicate effectively with co-workers, supervisors, vendors and contract personnel.</li><li>• Ability to treat others with dignity and respect in a variety of settings.</li><li>• Perform follow up and inspect completed work orders when applicable.</li><li>• Proactively support innovation and change.</li><li>• Demonstrated proficiency in verbal and written communications.</li><li>• Ability to work independently.</li><li>• Proficient in computer skills.</li><li>• Excellent listening skills.</li><li>• Possess the ability to lead problem-solving work sessions if asked.</li></ul>
